


#### Minali Patel




#### **Dhwani Amin**


#### Krishnendu Pal

Jayanta Banerjee, a successful sitarist, musician, and composer from a musical family, began his training under Late Sri Amit Prosonno Mukherjee and later studied with Pandit Debiprashad Chatterjee, Late Pandit Santosh Banerjee, and Late Pandit Robi Chakroborty through the Rampur and Maihar gharanas. His melodious sitar playing earned him recognition, including winning the National Youth Festival in 1997, which propelled his career.

Over the years, he has evolved as an accompanist, soloist, and composer, blending classical and world music styles such as Jazz and Flamenco. Jayanta has performed in over 13 countries, including the USA, UK, Australia, and Europe, accompanying renowned Indian classical dancers and musicians like Pandit Chitresh Das and Pandit Birju Maharaj. He continues to captivate audiences worldwide with his enchanting compositions, characterized by varied rhythmic structures and a deep dedication to his art.

Ghoshal's talent is recognized by prestigious institutions; he is a graded 'B High' artist of All India Radio (AIR) and Doordarshan. As an accomplished accompanist, he has shared the stage with respected names in Indian classical music and dance, traveling globally with artists like Pandit Birju Maharaj ji and Pandit Vijay Shankar ji. Throughout his career, Ghoshal has established himself as a respected tabla player, and as he continues to perform and teach, he plays a vital role in preserving and promoting the rich tradition of tabla playing in Indian classical music.







He has pursued both Graduation and Post Graduation on Music, specialized in Vocals from Visva Bharati University, Santiniketan. He is also an authorized Music Teacher of RSL Awards, London and holds a Level 6 UK Qualification- Teaching Diploma & PGCTL. He started his career as an Assistant Professor at Asian Academy of Film and Television, Noida, India and other organizations.

He is now continuing his teaching career at Symphony Sargam, Dubai. Smitten by the theatre from childhood, Sanjeev Dixit acted in school, college, and community plays growing up in India. As part of one of Dubai's leading English theatre groups 'Theatrics' since 2003, he was involved in every aspect of production be it acting, directing, choreographing, or writing songs on the fly. Sanjeev is also associated with Malhaar, Dubai's only classical Indian choir, and has staged grand Hindustani classical musicals with them. In 2012 he launched Third Half Theatre, a group committed to the theatre as an art form.

Sanjeev's plays have been staged at various short play festivals in Dubai and at The Emirates Litfest Fringe, The Sikka Art Fair, and have been performed in India and the USA. He wrote and directed the musical 'Amazing Dubai', a brainchild of social entrepreneur Brian Wilkie, which made its debut at the Madinat Theatre, Dubai and ran for six months. Featuring multi-national UAE based talent, it was a spectacular telling of the Emirate's journey from a small fishing community in the 1800s to one of the most modern metropolises in the world.

He then wrote and directed Sutradhar, a classic tale derived from the Mahabharata. He was the show director for the inaugural Bayut Your Home Your Choice Awards at the Dubai Opera, a Crayons event for Bayut. He wrote and directed The Emerald House, an Orb event for Fever at the Al Seef Heritage village in Dubai, which was

an interactive, immersive theatre experience. Sanjeev rounded off 2023 with an Anthology of his short plays and a revival of Malhaar's Haaye Akhtari, a musical celebrating

India's ghazal icon, Begum Akhtar. He recently directed a staging of Mahesh Dattani's important work on childhood trauma, 'Thirty Days in September' in collaboration with EnAct.

Sanjeev wrote and directed 'Still Dancing' in 2018, culminating in its first staging in April 2019. An attempt to humanize PD and showcase the issues and challenges faced by people with PD and their families, the play was recently revived and staged at The Emirates Theatre, Dubai in May 2023. It premiered in India in April 2024, with shows in Mumbai and Ahmedabad. All the shows were very enthusiastically received, with both Mumbai shows at the NCPA XP and the Royal Opera House receiving standing ovations.

Always up for a challenge, Sanjeev is driven by an eclectic style, fueled by a collaborative spirit and a desire to work across varied genres and themes. Meera: Echoes of Love marks his first collaboration with Symphony Sargam.
